



Professor Father Michael J. Kelly Memoriam Award 2022

The Father Michael Kelly Award is presented annually at the Professor Father Michael Kelly Lecture Series. This award recognises the work of and pays tribute to individuals who advocate for the promotion of education and social justice in the area of HIV and AIDS in Africa, and who have demonstrated personal courage, selflessness and leadership in the fight against HIV and AIDS.

Selection criteria

The awardee...

- Has worked to safeguard the human rights of those impacted by HIV and AIDS and especially the rights of women and girls
- Has made contributions to the promotion of girls' education and social justice in the area of HIV and AIDS
- Has demonstrated courage and selflessness in fighting HIV and AIDS
- Has demonstrated excellence as a thought leader in the response to HIV and AIDS
- Embodies the principles of respect and equity

Selection process

Candidates can be nominated through the Father Michael Kelly website, and the advisory panel will select the awardee. Calls for nominations will open mid-September.

Award process

The selected winner will be notified in advance of the annual lecture, and will be invited to the event in Dublin, held on December 1st, 2022.
